Course Description:

Women’s Ensemble consists of mostly freshman treble voices that learn and perform beginning to intermediate level choral music of varying styles throughout the school year. Performances are held at Newbury Park High School. This class is unique because it is a performing group, an academic class, and a co-curricular activity all in one. Because of this, there are many forms which must be signed, and policies that must be followed. Women’s Ensemble is a semester long class and students and parents should realize that responsible commitment is expected and that budgets are calculated upon that commitment. The Women’s Ensemble meets every day of the first semester, period 3.

The progression of Ensembles for NPBS choral is as follows:

Freshmen Tenors & Basses – Concert Choir Period one

Freshmen Altos & Sopranos – Women’s Ensemble

Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors – Any of the choral groups with the exception of Chamber Singers (Juniors and Seniors only)

Chamber Singers – Juniors and Seniors with concurrent enrollment in period one Concert Choir (mixed)

Men’s Chorus – Open to all men regardless of ensemble
